The manifestation is an homage to the composer Dora PEJAČEVIĆ, a unique figure in the history of music. Her astounding and prolific output in more recent times has won her much international acclaim.

The composer spent her happy childhood and youth at the Pejačević Castle composing here her first pieces of music.

A work of young Dora was introduced by Karl Kraus to Arnold Schoenberg and both of them praised her talent. However, as was always the case with Kraus, he showed his ambiguity regarding female talent by stating that composing was not meant for women to indulge in.



The aim of the masterclasses is to deepen and improve the interpretations of the pivotal music literature as well as to reveal gems from undeservedly neglected composers.

The lessons are held in the Castle of the Family Pejačević and participants reside close by in the very heart of the town. Practice studios are located in the Music School "The Duchess Dora" which is situated in the so-called 'Little' Castle right next to the 'Main' Castle.

The small number of participants - young talents, graduates and post-graduate students - enjoy the intensive attention of master musicians in a harmonious, non-competitive group environment. The unique musical talents of each participant are recognized and cultivated. We follow Pablo Casals motto "The goal of every musician is to bring music alive".

Pejačević Castle is surrounded by a gorgeous park in the heart of the small town of Našice. The town is situated in the picturesque region of Slavonia that further offers the visitor the opportunity to enjoy the deep silence and beauty of the Papuk National Park, a true jewel of nature. One could say that here music and nature give birth to each other.

An excursion, degustation of national dishes and high-quality wines are included in the price, offered by the amiable hosts.
